

Production Set Designer 2014 - 2015

This position does not require technical knowledge, only the ability to organize and see that those who do have the technical ability get the job done.

GUIDELINES

- 1. All bills go to the Producer
- 2. Consult with the Producer before purchasing any single item which costs more than \$100. Will use tax exempt forms for all purchases.
- 3. Supervise building of set liaise with Director and Production Director.
- 4. Oversee set construction work on Saturday or Sunday mornings.
- 5. Check and replenish supplies (paint, lumber, etc.)
- 6. Try to keep supplies in one place.
- 7. Attend production meeting and try to adhere to budget.
- 8. Oversee load-in of set and construction during set-up weekend.
- 9. Supervise striking of set and clean-up.
- 10. See that someone from Tech is at each performance to handle emergencies.
- 11. Clean up theatre after each workday and prior to Opening Night. All materials that were used are to be put away.
- 12. Coordinate with Producer and Production Director on beginning of stage construction and a set tech schedule.
